



### In a Nutshell





Catania is the second largest city in Sicily after its capital Palermo. It's located on the east coast of the island, at the foot of Mount Etna. Its Mediterranean climate gives to Catania mild and pleasant temperatures even in winter time, making it a destination ideal for year-round cruising.

Thanks to its strategic geographical position in the middle of the Mediterranean Sea, the port of Catania is an interesting destination for all itineraries, able to be conveniently included in both West Med and East Med tours.

Catania Cruise Port manages the cruise terminal of Catania offering transit, inter-porting and homeporting operations, as well as an increasingly wide range of ancillary services. The port has four preferential cruise docks with a berthing capacity of up to four ships, plus another dock that in case of need can host one or two more ships and berthing facilities to serve the latest generation cruise ships.





# **Mount Etna**



Etna is the largest European most active volcano. It never ceases to enchant with its lava flows and lunar landscapes. Through the centuries, its eruptions have shaped the volcano's slopes, designing unique sceneries of lava and ice.

The area is now an enormous nature reserve, full of walkable trails and an Astrophysical Observatory.


# Piazza Armerina

#### LOCATION

The port of Catania is located in the middle of the Mediterranean, equidistant from the Suez Canal, Gibraltar and all African and European ports: this is why it is the crossroads of major cruise itineraries.
